COURTESY TRANSLATION, THE ITALIAN TEXT PREVAIL

NOTICE FOR THE COLLECTION OF EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TECHNICAL COMMISSION AND THE TEST JURIE FOR THE COMMON TRAINING TEST – SAFETY TEST REFERRED TO POINT 2.1.3 AND 2.1.4 OF DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) 2019/907 OF 14 MARCH 2019, AS AMENDED.

HAVING REGARD TO article 2 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907, as subsequently amended, which sets out the contents of the Common Training Test (CTT) and the conditions to be met both for participation in and successful completion of the CTT;

WHEREAS Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/907, as amended by Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2023/865 of 23 February 2023, provides that: *«Ski instructors falling within the scope of this Regulation who have successfully completed the CTT or who enjoy acquired rights under Article 7 of this Regulation shall be issued a certificate of competence through the Internal Market Information (IMI) system established by Regulation (EU) No 1024/2012. The certificate attests to the successful completion of a CTT and shall be issued by a competent authority in a Member State»*

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION that, as indicated in Annex I to the abovementioned Regulation, as amended by Delegated Regulation (EU) 2023/865 of 23 February 2024, in Italy the competent authorities include, inter alia, the Regions and the Autonomous Provinces of Trento and Bolzano, which, pursuant to Recital (8), “have exclusive competence to issue the qualification of ‘Ski Instructor’ and may delegate this power to other Italian bodies listed in Annex I to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907”;

CONSIDERING that the Common Training Test (CTT) constitutes a standardised aptitude test available among the participating Member States and reserved for holders of specific professional qualifications; in accordance with Article 49c(1) of Directive 2005/36/EC, successful completion of said test in one Member State entitles the holder of a specific professional qualification to pursue the profession in the host Member State under the same conditions applicable to holders of professional qualifications obtained in that Member State;

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION that pursuant to point 2.1.3 of Annex II to Regulation (EU) 2019/907, *“The Safety Test shall be organised under the responsibility of the competent authority for the training of ski instructors in the respective territory of the Member State in which the Safety Test takes place, following an agreement with a Technical Commission established for that purpose. The Technical Commission shall be composed of qualified citizens of any Member State and shall represent at least three Member States. Such citizens shall be designated by the organising Member State or, as appropriate, by the competent authority, on the basis of their competence and professional experience in the field. The organising Member State or competent authority shall notify the dates of the Safety Test to the Commission and to the other Member States or competent authorities at least two months in advance.”*

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION that pursuant to point 2.1.4 of Annex II to Regulation (EU) 2019/907, “Examination Boards shall oversee and ensure the proper implementation of the Safety Test. Membership in the Examination Boards for the Safety Test shall be open to qualified citizens of all Member States. Only citizens who have passed the Safety Test before the entry into force of this Regulation or who have passed the CTT shall be eligible for appointment to the Test Jurie for assessing the modules of the Safety Test. These Test Jurie shall be designated by the organising Member State or, as appropriate, by the competent authority, based on their competence and professional experience in the field. The organising Member State or competent authority may delegate this power of appointment to third parties, but members of the Test Jurie shall always represent at least three Member States. Member States or competent authorities other than those organising the CTT may submit proposals for the composition of the Test Jurie. In such cases, the organising Member State or, as appropriate, the competent authority, may reject such proposals only on duly justified grounds.”

HAVING REGARD TO the document prepared by the Group of Coordinators for Directive 2005/36/EC dated 24 June 2025, which is hereby fully incorporated by reference, from which it emerges that, for the purposes of eligibility as a member of the “Technical Commission”, it is necessary to be a qualified citizen of an EU or assimilated State⁽¹⁾; whereas individuals not holding a certificate of successful completion of the Common Training Test (or “Eurosécurité”) or not in possession of specific certifications shall nevertheless be eligible for appointment, provided that such appointment is made on the basis of proven competence and professional experience.

HAVING REGARD TO the document prepared by the Group of Coordinators for Directive 2005/36/EC dated 24 June 2025, which clarifies that, for eligibility as a member of the Test Jurie, the following requirements must be met: (a) being a qualified citizen of an EU or assimilated State (see note 1); (b) having successfully completed the Common Training Test or the “eurosécurité” prior to the entry into force of the Regulation.

CONSIDERING the same document, which further specifies that both the Technical Commission and the Test Jurie for the Safety Test must include members representing at least three Member States;

WHEREAS pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 2, of Law No. 81 of 8 March 1991, the qualification courses for the ski instructor profession are organised by the Regions, in cooperation with the regional and provincial Colleges as well as the technical bodies of the Federazione italiana sport invernali (FISI), in accordance with procedures established by regional legislation;

HAVING REGARD TO Regional Law No. 50 of 23 November 1992, as amended, on the “Regulation of the Ski Instructor Profession”;

HAVING REGARD TO Regional Law No. 33 of 26 November 2001 (Regulation of Tourism Professions and amendments to Regional Law No. 50 of 23 November 1992);

HAVING REGARD TO Regional Law No. 14 of 8 April 2024 introducing the qualification of “Allievo Maestro”;

HAVING REGARD TO the Resolution of the Regional Government No. 6-142/2024/XII of 6 September 2024, pursuant to which the commissions are appointed by the Collegio Regionale Maestri sci del Piemonte under an agreement with the Regione Piemonte;

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the Collegio Regionale Maestri sci del Piemonte to proceed with the appointment of both the Technical Commission and the Test Jurie;

THE PRESIDENT COLLEGIO REGIONALE MAESTRI SCI DEL PIEMONTE HEREBY GIVES NOTICE THAT

A call for expressions of interest is hereby launched with the purpose of identifying a shortlist of candidates from which, pursuant to the criteria set out in points 2.1.3 and 2.1.4 of Annex II to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907, the **Technical Commission** and the **Test Jurie** will be established.

Art. 1

(Purpose of the Call)

1. The present notice aims to conduct a market survey for the selection of members to compose the following commissions, to be employed for the **Common Training Test – Safety Test**:
(a) **Technical Commission**; (b) **Test Jurie**.

Art. 2

(Eligibility Requirements)

1. To submit an application under this notice, candidates must, as of the date of submission, meet the following eligibility requirements:

(a) **Common requirements for both commissions:**

- i. be Italian citizens or nationals of any other Member State of the European Union, including citizens of EFTA/EEA States or third-country nationals benefiting from equal treatment (e.g. long-term residents, seasonal workers);
- ii. enjoy full civil and political rights;
- iii. have no criminal convictions resulting in disqualification from exercising the profession of ski instructor, and not be subject to preventive measures, civil judgments or administrative orders entailing such measures, as recorded in the criminal register;
- iv. not be subject to any pending criminal proceedings;
- v. not be involved in any civil or administrative litigation and not be party to judicial proceedings against the Collegio regionale maestro sci del Piemonte or any other Collegi regionali, provinciali e Nazionale;
- vi. hold a valid third-party liability (TPL) insurance policy covering their professional activities.

(b) **Specific requirements for eligibility as a member of the Technical Commission:**

- i. hold a professional qualification listed in Annex I to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907;
- ii. possess proven and substantial professional experience and expertise in mountain safety, self-rescue operations, topography, cartography, and snowpack assessment.

(c) Specific requirements for eligibility as a member of the Test Jurie:

- i. hold a professional qualification listed in Annex I to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907;
 - ii. have successfully passed the Common Training Test or the “Eurosécurité” before the entry into force of the Regulation.
2. The possession of the requirements referred to in paragraph 1, lett. (a) and the absence of grounds for exclusion shall be certified through a self-declaration made pursuant to DPR No. 445/2000, signed by the applicant under his or her personal responsibility and for all legal purposes, acknowledging the criminal consequences of false statements. Such declaration shall be attached to the application for participation (Annexes A1_ENG and A2_ENG);
3. The possession of the requirements referred to in paragraph 1, lett. (b), point (i) shall be demonstrated by attaching the relevant professional qualification or by providing the certificate obtainable via the Internal Market Information (IMI)⁽²⁾ For point (ii), a detailed *Curriculum Vitae* (CV) shall be attached to the application, evidencing substantial professional experience and competence in mountain safety, self-rescue operations, and snowpack hazard assessment. Registration in the Register of Alpine Guides shall be considered an asset and constitute a preferential title for selection purposes;
4. The possession of the requirements referred to in paragraph 1, lett. (c), point (i) shall be demonstrated by attaching the relevant professional qualification or the certificate obtainable via the IMI system; for point (ii), a suitable certificate attesting the successful completion of the Common Training Test – Safety Test (PFC-S) or of the *eurosécurité*, obtained prior to the entry into force of Regulation (EU) 2019/907, shall be attached to the application.⁽³⁾

Art. 3

(Composition of the Commissions)

1. **Technical Commission:** following the collection of expressions of interest and verification of the effective possession of the eligibility requirements referred to in Article 2 of the present notice, the Collegio shall proceed to establish the Technical Commission, which shall be composed as follows:
 - (a) **1 President**, appointed by the Collegio Regionale Maestri sci del Piemonte (without voting rights), who may not necessarily meet the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1, lett. (b), points (i) and (ii);
 - (b) **1 Secretary**, designated by the Training Agency entrusted with the organisation of the course (without voting rights), who may not necessarily meet the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1(b), points (i) and (ii);
 - (c) **5 Technical Members** (with voting rights), meeting the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1, lett. (b), points (i) and (ii), two (2) of whom shall be nationals of EU (or assimilated) Member States other than Italy.

2. **Test Jurie:** following the collection of expressions of interest and verification of the effective possession of the eligibility requirements referred to in Article 2 of the present notice, the College shall proceed to establish the Examination Board, which shall be composed as follows:

- (a) **1 President**, appointed by the Regional College (without voting rights), who may not necessarily meet the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1; lett. (c), points (i) and (ii);
- (b) **1 Secretary**, designated by the Training Agency entrusted with the organisation of the course (without voting rights), who may not necessarily meet the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1, lett. (c), points (i) and (ii);
- (c) **5 Technical Members** (with voting rights), meeting the requirements set out in Article 2, paragraph 1, lett. (c), points (i) and (ii), two (2) of whom shall be nationals of EU (or assimilated) Member States other than Italy.

Art. 4

(Duration of appointment)

1. the lists thus established shall remain valid for the duration of the 2025–2026 training course, unless their validity is extended or replacements are deemed necessary.

Art. 5

(Place of performance of duties)

1. For the **Test Jurie**: the Common Training Test – Safety Test shall take place on **23–25 January 2026** (Group 1) and **30–31 January and 1 February 2026** (Group 2) in Alagna Valsesia (VC), subject to possible make-up days and changes of dates or location;
2. For the **Technical Commission**: the activities shall be limited to the competences assigned there to under point 2.1.3 of Annex II to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907 and shall be carried out online on a date to be determined, tentatively between 15 and 30 November 2025.

Art. 6

(Submission of applications)

1. Interested individuals (dead line for either commission) shall submit their application – Form A1_ENG for the Technical Commission or Form A2_ENG for the Test jurie – no later than 17:00 on **30 November 2025**, to the following addresses: Certified email (PEC): collegio@pec.maestriscipiemonte.it or standard email: info@maestriscipiemonte.it

Art. 7

(Financial provisions)

1. Members of the commissions shall be entitled to the daily allowance established by the Training Agency entrusted with the organisation and delivery of the course.

Art. 8

(Data protection)

1. The personal data provided by applicants shall be processed in full compliance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) – Regulation (EU) 2016/679, and of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018.

Art. 9

(Publication)

1. The present call for expressions of interest shall be published on the official website of the Regional College, section “Amministrazione Trasparente”, first-level subsection “Bandi e Contratti”, until the closing date indicated herein, and shall be transmitted to the European Commission and to the other Member States or competent authorities and on the Collegio Nazionale maestri di sci website.

Art. 10

(Final Provision)

1. Applications for participation in the expression of interest referred to in this document shall be accepted exclusively if submitted using the official forms attached to the present notice (Models A1_ENG and A2_ENG) and duly completed in all parts (see Table 1).
2. Incomplete applications, applications not submitted on the official forms, or applications lacking, even in part, the required documentation shall not be taken into consideration and shall entail the automatic exclusion of the applicant from the procedure;
3. Should a competent authority of a Member State other than Italy wish to participate in the procedure through its own representatives, provided that they meet the requirements set out in Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/907, it may transmit the required documentation to the Collegio Regionale maestri sci del Piemonte. However, such documentation must refer specifically to each individual candidate proposed as a member of the commission and must be personally signed by the candidate concerned.
